ONE PARISH ONE PRISONER (OPOP) Our OPOP team of seven, has been working with Underground Ministries since March 2023 to develop a relationship with our incarcerated friend, Raymond. We are excited to report that we are now able to share phone calls and emails. We are busy identifying "Stones" or roadblocks that might get in the way of his transition to civilian life upon his release in January. Raymond is now in a work release program in Seattle. He will be 25 years old on August 31 and for his birthday our team bought him a computer to help with job hunting, emails, and work study. The OPOP program challenges us to walk alongside in friendship and support while together we work through monthly learning modules.
