One Parish One Prisoner Team April Update.

Our friend Ray has been struggling in his resurrection journey home from prison. We can't give all the details but here is some of the story. We are learning how difficult reentry is for millions of men and women trying to heal and rebuild lives after prison. We are learning about the "stones" that are so hard to roll away, like addiction. As we get to know our friend better, we are learning more about the trauma, his long history of pain that's slow to heal beneath the "layers" of unhealthy behaviors.

The OPOP program actually includes this part of the journey. We are continuing to meet as a team on the first Wednesday of every month to pray and learn from additional chapters in our curriculum. We invited you to pray with us for Ray. We know God's love can reach him wherever he is.Pray that we grow in compassion for all those who are in the underground of jail, prison, and addiction.
